2020-2021


- The Feedback on curriculum was collected from major stake holders in a structured format through questionnaires. The respondents were the Major stakeholders of the institutions namely Alumni, Employers', Students and Teaching Staff.
- The student feedback on curriculum was collected from students by administering the questionnaires to all students present in the institute on a predetermined working day.

47% of students found the assignment / seminar had relevance as a part of course evaluation. 51% agreed, the availability of infrastructure & learning resources in the college for the delivery of curriculum. 46% found that the current curriculum encourage the student to take up higher studies & research. 50% have very good Views on the depth of the curriculum including project works & practical's . 50% have very good views on Extent of content included in the course 52% gave very good opinion on Learning values of the course offered .38% say that The competency of curriculum in the global employment market .49% have very Good opinion on course designed. 54% found very good Rate the size of syllabi in terms of the load on the student .40% rate very good rate the evaluation scheme designed for each of the subjects.
- The teacher feedback on curriculum was collected from all faculty of the institute including the UGC Staff, Management staff of UG and PG sections of the institution, by administering the questionnaire in the structured format. 32% agree, the syllabi upholds the mental and physical growth of the student. 41% found The learning objectives are fulfill the needs of the student. 47% say the present curriculum is helpful to appear for competitive work .36% found very good Views on the depth of the curriculum including project works & practical. 28% found the present encourage the students to take up higher studies and research. 51% agree Competency of curriculum to compete in global employment market. 47% have the Good response availability of infrastructure and learning resources of the college for delivery of curriculum. 35% found very good response on Contribution of the curriculum for the enhancement of student personality. 58% agree good response on the size of syllabi in terms of the load on the student, 50% gave good response on the Overall opinion of the course.
- The valuable alumni feedback on curriculum was collected from alumni's of the Institutions by the structured framing of the questionnaires, as and when the alumni's visited the institution. 34% responded the syllabi created interest to pursue post-graduation/Research in the particular topic. 42% agree that the evaluation scheme designed for the course is very good. 37% agree the syllabus updated enough. 34% gave Good opinion on the course content delivery interesting to them. 37% found the course curriculum fulfilling the expectations. 32% agree the syllabi have practical applicability. 45% have satisfactory response on the course contributes to the moral and social well-being of the students, The

new skills in the due course of your study were good according to 40% of alumnus.38% agree the course/syllabus of each subject increase your knowledge and perspective in the subject area.42% rate good about the rate the evaluation scheme designed for the course.41% rate that aims and objectives of the syllabi well defined and clear to the teachers and students.

- The employer feedback on curriculum was collected from those who visited the campus for on-campus placement activity. 
Action Taken Report: 2020-2021

- To encourage and enhance subject knowledge of the faculties, the college provides maximum support to participate in seminars, Workshops, Conferences, FDP etc.
- The suggestion regarding the curriculum from faculties will be forwarded to the BOS of Mangalore University (Affiliated University) which shall contribute towards offering skill oriented, practically applicable knowledge through their curriculum.
- To uplift the student-teachers interactions and develop organizing skills among the students, the college encourage in organizing extra-curricular activities in the campus.
- The Faculty Development Programme (FDP) on “ENGAGING MINDS and EMPOWERING SUCCESS in MODERN RESEARCH ERA” 3 day International Faculty Development Programme, participants from India and abroad have taken part and benefited. This programme was jointly organized by IQAC and Department of Post Graduate studies and Research in Commerce.
- On behalf of Librarian day, (father of Library Science, Dr. S.R. Ranganathan) Govinda Dasa College Library and IQAC jointly organized National Level e-Quiz on the topic Library and Information Science,
- On the occasion of the International Human Rights Day, the Department of Humanities, the Human Rights and Consumer Forum and the Mahila Vedike of our college jointly organized a State Level Webinar as well as Justice Suresh Hosabettu Endowment Lecture on “Human Rights”.
- The Rural Entrepreneurship Development Cell, in association with GDC ED cell, conducted an online workshop for motivating and promoting Rural Entrepreneurship through preparation of ‘BUSINESSPLAN’. A webinar was conducted on the topic “Investments and Mutual Funds” for the M.Com students.
- A staff empowerment programme, “Online teaching” a training programme was done for Staff members of the College. The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of Govinda Dasa College, in association with, Vidyadayinee Institute of Agriculture and Rural Training (VIRAT), organized a 40 hours Computer Training Course for the teaching and non-teaching staff of the college.
- Students encouraged to Interview an Entrepreneur, of nearby and to form the report of their business they hold which helped them to learn the practical skill of business.
- ‘SWARAJYA@75’ a webinar in association with Disha Bharath was organized for the students for their skill development.

- A Seminar on about mind mapping system in Artificial intelligence. for PG students for knowledge building in the technological field.
- As an part of skill development, “A virtual Company” Concept for students, to build the knowledge and ideas in cost and accounting field. “rangatarabethi” for all 1st year degree students to build Confidence in communication and verbal skills,
- A guest lecture to improve the research skills in students “Research Article Writing: Why and How”, a Guest Lecture on “Artificial Intelligence Models” for PG students was organized by the department. “a talk on Quantum Mechanics” by department of physics, “ Reflection Of Strategies” a Practical session for BBA students to learn the history of business.
- Post Graduate Department of Commerce, in association with, JCI Surathkal organised 2 days webinar on Skill Development Programme
- On the eve of National Farmers’ Day, the PG department of Chemistry organized a talk on Organic Farming and Terrace Gardening, with the practical sessions to students and general public. As an outreach initiative towards farmers.
