Administration:

Govinda Dasa College, founded in 1967, has a long standing tradition of providing high quality education to students from Surathkal and its surrounding regions for more than five decades. With a commitment to academic excellence and holistic development, the college has earned a strong reputation for fostering both intellectual growth and character building among its students.

The institution is managed by the Hindu Vidyadayinee Sangha (R.) of Surathkal, a respected organization dedicated to the promotion of education and social welfare. The college is affiliated with Mangalore University, which ensures that the courses and programs offered align with the university's academic standards and guidelines.

Govinda Dasa College has received recognition for its outstanding academic performance and institutional development, earning an "A" grade and a commendable CGPA of 3.14 from the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC). This accreditation reflects the college's consistent efforts to provide an enriching educational experience, with a focus on quality teaching, infrastructure, research, and student support services. Over the years, the college has grown into a leading educational institution in the region, with a strong track record of producing well rounded graduates equipped to meet the challenges of the modern world.

The B.B.A. (Bachelor of Business Administration) and B.C.A. (Bachelor of Computer Applications) course are recognized and approved by the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), ensuring that the programs meet the required standards for technical and professional education in India.

Our college has been accredited by the Institution's Innovation Council (IIC), in accordance with the guidelines set by the Innovation Cell of the Ministry of Education, Government of India.

Since March 31, 2024, Prof. Gopal M. Gokhale has taken over as the new Administrative Director of the college, continuing the legacy of leadership and ensuring the college's continued growth and success.

Various Courses:

Our college offers a diverse range of undergraduate and postgraduate programs to meet the educational needs and career aspirations of students. The undergraduate programs include Bachelor of Arts (B.A.), Bachelor of Science (B.Sc.), Bachelor of Commerce (B.Com.), Bachelor of Computer Applications (B.C.A.), and Bachelor of Business Administration (B.B.A.). For postgraduate studies, we provide Master of Commerce (M.Com.) and Master of Science in Chemistry (M.Sc. Chemistry) programs.

In the academic year 2023-2024, our student body consists of a total of 614 students. Of these, 505 are pursuing undergraduate degrees across various disciplines, reflecting a strong interest in foundational and applied sciences, commerce, and the arts. The postgraduate department has 109 students, who are furthering their specialization in fields like commerce and chemistry, positioning themselves for advanced roles in academia, industry, and research.

Our college's commitment to high quality education and a well rounded curriculum aims to prepare students for future challenges and opportunities in their respective fields.

Our college offers a comprehensive selection of certificate courses in collaboration with Mangalore University, Dakshina Kannada District Consumer Association, and our internal departments. These programs are designed to equip students with specialized skills that enhance both their academic and professional profiles.

Recognized by Mangalore University, we offer certificate courses in Computer Accounting and Taxation, which focuses on essential accounting software and tax regulations, and Computer Hardware and Networking, which provides foundational and advanced knowledge in managing computer systems and networks. Additionally, our Vermitechnology course delves into eco friendly practices, teaching students sustainable methods of organic waste management using earthworms.

In collaboration with the Dakshina Kannada District Consumer Association, we provide certificate courses in Human Rights and Consumer Education, raising awareness about individual rights, consumer protection, and advocacy. The college offers specialized certificate courses in Theater, Music, and Yakshagana, encouraging students to engage with and preserve traditional regional art forms.

The Department of Commerce and Business Administration offers a Banking certificate course that familiarizes students with essential banking concepts and practices, preparing them for roles in the financial sector. Other notable offerings include the Certified Management Accountant (C.M.A.) course, which covers financial management and strategic planning, as well as the Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP) and Digital Marketing courses, which equip students with valuable, in demand skills for today's business environment.

Starting this year, we have also introduced Chartered Accountant (C.A.) and Company Secretary (C.S.) courses. To support these, we have established a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the Pariksha Academy to provide structured training and resources for students pursuing professional certifications in accountancy and corporate governance.

Moreover, our college has the distinction of being recognized as a NEET (National Eligibility cum Entrance Test) examination center by the central government.
